A SPECIALLY TRAINED OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST (OT) DETERMINES WHETHER A CHILD WOULD BENEFIT FROM SIT. THE OT WILL THEN EXPOSE THE CHILD TO SENSORY STIMULATION THROUGH REPETITIVE ACTIVITIES.

## **Speech and Language Therapy:**

Speech and Language Therapy is an approach enabling the rehabilitation of physical and/or cognitive deficits/disorders resulting in difficulty in communication (expressive or receptive) and social interaction. This includes both speech (articulation, intonation, rate,intensity) and language (phonology, morphology, syntax, semantics, pragmatics, both receptive and expressive language, including reading and writing). In our center speech therapists provide individual therapy to help the children develop communication skills. Intensive therapy will help children learn to emote, enact and speak their minds effectively and comprehensively. Children with unclear speech, fluency, resonance, weak oral muscles, swallowing issues, picky eaters and communication issues also can be benefitted through speech and language therapy.

## **Behavioral therapy (Behavior Modification)**

In MMRI we provide 'Behavioral Intervention' program that include parent counseling, behaviour modification and collaborating with the family, teachers and other mental health professionals to design an effective intervention plan for the child. Additionally, parents are taught how to interact with their child in a positive way that is developmentally appropriate and move on to set reasonable expectations from their child. through BT we aim to increase desirable behaviours in child, improve parent-child interactions and bring about a positive family atmosphere, all of which help in building an environment conducive for their child's growth.

## **Special Education**

Our special Education program aims to ensure every child's educational needs and it facilitates effective learning in children. Often various psychological and behavioral concerns manifest themselves in the form of reading and writing difficulties, inability to concentrate or comprehend instructions in children. These difficulties impair a child's ability to learn new concepts. Our tailor-made Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) along with successful collaboration between special educators, parents and teachers help children to prepare and cope with the demands of learning and mainstream education.
