# **Psychology and counseling**

In MMRI, we have a team of specialized Clinical and Rehabilitation Psychologists who are trained to administer psychological and developmental assessments for children. They also work with parents to develop inclusive and integrated home management strategies.

Developmental evaluation can help families to identify children with special needs, and provide information about the requirement of early intervention which would help children reach their full potential both at home and at school. Our team of psychologists and behavior therapists enhance the parents' understanding of their child's difficulties and spend time in establishing a shared goal between the team and the caregiver. The multi- disciplinary team continually monitors the child's progress in therapy in order to identify areas of growth, to determine efficacy of treatment plans, and/or to recommend modifications to the ongoing treatment.

### **Occupational Therapy**

Occupational Therapy works on sensory difficulties, motor planning, visual perception skills, with modifications to their fine motor skills and self-care tasks, which may be difficult for the child to exhibit. Our OT team helps children with developmental challenges to improve/develop skills that will lead to success in everyday life functions.
